WeirdBeard was founded in 2007 by Niels Monshouwer and Joram Rafalowicz. Based in Amsterdam, the studio strives to create recognizable yet also surprising gameplay as their trademark. Their games are accessible for all ages whilst still providing a challenge for the more experienced gamer, such as the mobile game [99 Bricks Wizard Academy](#), a puzzle building game released in 2014.

Their latest magical puzzle game is [Tricky Towers](#), playable on the PC (Windows, Mac, Linux and Steam OS), PlayStation®4, and soon for Xbox One. Players are challenged to create the tallest stable tower using their engineering skills, and a little magic. Towers can be built in single player, or local and online multiplayer modes.

Tricky Towers can be purchased from [Steam](#) or the [PlayStation](#) store for €14,99, and was available for free to PlayStation Plus subscribers in August 2016. Players can also download the game's soundtrack for free, or buy a number of decorative addons to change the appearance of their bricks or wizards – including the Indie Friends DLC, adding characters from several well-known indie games.
